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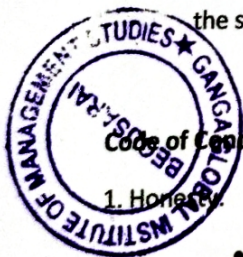

Objectives:

- Quality, Integrity, and Ethics: Ensure adherence to quality standards, integrity, and ethics in all research activities.
- Publication and Presentation: Encourage and facilitate the publication of research works in reputable academic journals and facilitate presentations at academic events.
- Identification of Research Opportunities: Identify and inform researchers about research opportunities announced by academic, research, industry, or government organizations.
- Interdisciplinary Research: Promote interdisciplinary research involving multiple knowledge domains.
- Support and Guidance: Facilitate professional guidance, technical support, and financial assistance for research endeavours.
- Establishment of Linkages: Identify and establish linkages, including Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs), with national and international research organizations to broaden the scope of research opportunities.



Code of Conduct for Research:

1. Honesty:

- The researchers should not falsify, fabricate, plagiarize, mislead, or misrepresent research findings.
- They should adhere to accepted practices in the specific research discipline.
- They ought to obtain all necessary licenses, permits, permissions, and follow the necessary protocols.

2. Transparency:

- The researchers should share research methodology, data, and findings openly, responsibly, and accurately.
- They are under obligation to disclose and manage conflicts of interest.

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3. Fairness:

- The researchers should treat fellow researchers and others involved in the research fairly and with respect.
- They should appropriately provide references and citations in their research papers.
- They are expected to give due credit including authorship to those who have contributed to the research.

4. Recordkeeping:

The researchers should maintain clear, accurate, secure, and complete records of all research, including data and primary materials.

5. Conflicts of Interest:

They are required to disclose and manage any actual, potential, or perceived conflicts of interest.

6. Publication and Authorship:

- The researchers should include all authors who have made a significant intellectual contribution to the research and its output.
- They must cite and acknowledge the work of other authors appropriately and obtain permission for the use of unpublished work.
- They are required to acknowledge contributions from professional and technical staff, institutions, funders, and shared facilities.

7. Human Research Ethics:

- The researchers are under obligation to apply ethical principles in the conduct of all human research.
- They are required to obtain approval from the appropriate ethics review body before conducting research involving humans.

8. Animal Research Ethics:

- The researchers are required to obtain approval from an appropriate animal ethics review body before conducting research involving animals.
- They should ensure that there is minimum impact on animals used in research and also support their welfare and wellbeing.

Code of Ethics for Plagiarism Check:

- Raising awareness among faculty and students regarding responsible conduct of research and prevention of misconduct, including plagiarism.
- Developing systems to detect and prevent plagiarism.
- Utilizing plagiarism detection software such as Turnitin and other online tools.
- Taking appropriate action against any instances of plagiarism.
